- We work to increase people facing hunger's access to nutritious and culturally preferred foods, resources and civic engagement opportunities.
- We act together as one Network to serve people facing hunger, no matter their geographic location or circumstance.
- We foster pathways for people facing hunger to engage in the movement to end hunger.
- We strive to strengthen a diverse and inclusive Network that recognizes multiple parties contribute to the work necessary to achieve our vision including partner food banks, agency partners, affiliate food banks, redistribution organizations, regional cooperatives, partner state associations and a national organization.
- We are interdependent peers and partners who benefit from each other's experiences and active participation in our Network.
- We commit to open, respectful communication.
- We cultivate trust with each other and assume positive intent.
- We listen with empathy.
- We collaborate and build community at the local, state, regional and national level.
- We share leadership and make decisions through processes that are clear, transparent and known.
- We expect constructive conflict as rigorous dialogue leads to more informed, thoughtful decision-making.
- While pursuing our unifying vision, we value adaptations and choices aligned with the needs and strengths of local communities.
- We make room for mistakes while striving to learn and continually improve.
- We take conscientious care of the resources entrusted to us including food, funds, information, community and member trust, and employee well- being and careers.

- Ensure safe food handling through monitor visits and compliance checks
- Give you access to an online ordering system with live inventory
- Provide convenient online ordering and scheduling
- Deliver your orders at no charge if you receive deliveries from us
- Provide you a variety of food products, including produce, protein, perishable and nonperishable items
- Grant you exclusive access to National and Local retail donations through our Feeding
 America Membership
- Waive all fees for fresh produce, TEFAP and donated food
- Keep nutrition as our number one priority when selecting food to provide to our partners
- Order food in bulk to ensure the lowest available price on purchased product
- Offer you convenient access to retail donations through Agency Enabled Pickups

Terms of Engagement
